

## In News

- Mixed weekly performance for Kuwait Boursa indices.
- The All-Share Index closed at 7,949.2 points, a weekly increase of 0.21%, or 16.67 points.
- The Premier Market Index rose by 0.93%, or 78.89 points, to close the week trading at 8,561.90 points.
- The Main Market Index fell by 3.14%, losing 22,917 points, to reach 7,067.6 points.
- The Main Market Index 50 closed at 7,101.96 points, a weekly decline of 2.81%, or 205.42 points.
- The price of Kuwaiti oil fell \$2.41 to \$62.41 per barrel in trading last Friday, compared to \$64.82 per barrel in Trading the previous day, last Thursday.
- In global markets, Brent crude futures fell 84 cents to \$61.29 per barrel, while US West Texas Intermediate crude Futures fell 95 cents to \$58.29.
